We can use:

Recent and popular fiction and nonfiction in good condition.

Art and cookbooks are particularly desirable.

Music CDs and LP records in good condition.

DVD, videotapes and audio books on CD.

We do not want:

Reader's Digest Condensed Books

Textbooks

Cassette tapes of any kind

Please put donated books into boxes. Place them on the table inside at the side entrance of the Library during open hours. Receipts are available at the Adult circulation desk. Receipts give only the number of items donated and **not** a dollar amount of the estimated value.
