



Video Recording Policy

The Warner Library places a high priority on the privacy of its patrons. To this end, public filming or video streaming in the building is regulated by the following policy. For the purposes of this policy 'video streaming' includes any live transmission of images, including video calls and virtual meetings.

In order to protect minors in the library video recording or streaming is barred on the first floor children's room, as well as in the Teen Area on the second floor. Video recording or streaming is also barred in the private areas of the library, including meetings rooms when in use by outside organizations, except by members of such a meeting.

In areas not listed above the public is able to record or stream freely, as long as they do not violate the Patron Code of Conduct Policy.

The Library may take photographs or video of library events for publicity purposes. By attending any library event participants consent to photography, audio and video recording by the library staff for library use only. Particular patrons can ask not to be photographed or recorded and the library staff will attempt to abide by these wishes while continuing to document the event. The Library will make efforts to remove images from library publications if asked to by a particular patron included in the photograph or video, but this may not always be possible.
